



## Vision Services for Children

- Good vision is important for your child's learning.
- When vision problems are found early, it is often possible to correct them or prevent them from getting worse.
- **All children should see an optometrist before kindergarten, to start school ready to learn.**

- B.C. Medical Services Plan covers vision check-ups once a year for children under age 19.
- Some eye clinics have charges associated with children's eye exams.
- It is a good idea to call eye clinics before you schedule an appointment to ask about costs and other services such as languages spoken.
